Malaysia Company Law - Read online for free. Malaysia Company Law. The first point in a study of company law is to define, precisely what is meant by a company. The definition in the Companies Act 1963 states that a company means a company formed and registered under this Act or an existing company. The property of the company belongs to the company itself and not to the individual members, so that even the largest shareholder has no insurable interest in the property of the company. Therefore, a change in membership of a company will have no effect on the ownership of the company's assets.
