Lexicography is the theory and practice of compiling dictionaries. The term dictionary is used to denote a book listing words of a language and dealing with their meanings, pronunciation, origin, or other aspects. The history of English lexicography dates back to the Old English period when religious books were translated from Latin and lists of selected English-Latin equivalents "glossaries" were made up. Notwithstanding certain demerits this dictionary marks the beginning of English lexicography as a science. It served the foundation of the most comprehensive and authoritative dictionary of the English language "The Oxford English Dictionary, compiled by the English Philological Society (1888 " 1928) and aimed at the objective recording of the language. Definition: Lexicography is the theory and practice of compiling dictionaries. It's an important part of applied linguistics. The word "lexicography" is of the Greek origin as well as lexicography. "Lexicography" belongs to word and "lexis" means learning, if we translate it into English it means "learning of words". A short Akkadian wordlist from central Mesopotamia has survived from the 7th c. B.C. The Western tradition of dictionary making began among the Greeks, although not until the language had changed so much that explanations and commentaries were needed. After a 1st c.
