

It works especially well with students who can apply their own experiences building a snowman. Readers can also connect to facts they've learned about melting snow from other texts, like The Snowy Day. This is a read aloud story of Snowmen At Night by Caralyn Buehner and Mark Buehner. Words to model are embedded throughout the story. The 2018 Saltillo Calendar highlighted this story for January and suggested 5 words to model: I, what, wait, not, and do. Additional words for modeling are included in this read aloud: read, more, turn the page, the end, and read again.
