I think the current order is fine, but I see value in providing the user the ability to change the sorting, especially to alphabetical. New believers struggle with canonical order, especially in areas that have a mix of bible orders present. How about a setting. A global option button to choose the sort order for verse chooser. I don't know if it should also affect scrolling (to next book) or not, but that might be worth considering.
