The Old Testament (often abbreviated OT) is the first part of the Christian biblical canon, which is based primarily upon the twenty-four books of the Hebrew Bible (or Tanakh), a collection of ancient religious Hebrew writings by the Israelites believed by most Christians and religious Jews to be the sacred Word of God. The second part of Christian Bibles is the New Testament, written in the Koine Greek language. The Hebrew canon, or Old Testament, refers to the collection of Hebrew (and some Aramaic) books that were recognized as Scripture in ancient Israel. The traditional order we're talking about is referred to as "TaNaK." The TaNaK is an acronym for the names of the three large subcollections of the Hebrew Bible: Torah, Nevi'im, and Ketuvim. See how the whole order of the Old Testament is actually much different than you may think, and is the same order Jesus would have read them in. Milestones. In the beginning.
