12. Budget Planning. Every project boils down to money. If you had a bigger budget, you could probably get more people to do your project more quickly and deliver more. The most accurate and time-consuming estimating method is to identify the cost of each item in each activity of the schedule, including labour and materials. If you view the project schedule as a hierarchy where the general descriptions of tasks are at the top and the lower levels become more detailed, finding the price of each item at the lowest level and then summing them to determine the cost of higher levels is called bottom-up estimating. Example: Bottom-Up Estimate for John's Move. On larger projects, software that manages schedules can also manage costs and display them by activity and category.
