The major means of the transformation of innate mind into higher mind is language, which enables us to preserve and transmit the experience of generations. Vygotsky characterized his approach as “height psychology” (as opposed to “depth psychology”) and posited that the higher forms of mind should be the starting point for the study of human development.
