Daniel 7:13-14 - I saw in the night visions, and, behold, [one] like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion [is] an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom [that] which shall not be destroyed. Daniel is an Old Testament book about and supposedly by Daniel (an advisor to the King) who foretold the future. It combines six chapters about the court of Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon, with a further six chapters of vague prophecy. There are also a few apocryphal chapters which may or may not be present in your Bible. Daniel is not technically a prophet in the Jewish sense, since he talked with angels not God, and since he talked to future generations not the current generation.
